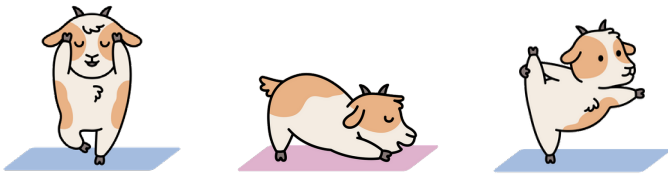

In the summer there is nothing like a refreshing swim after a long day at work. Come and take a dip or swim a few laps while catching up with friends.

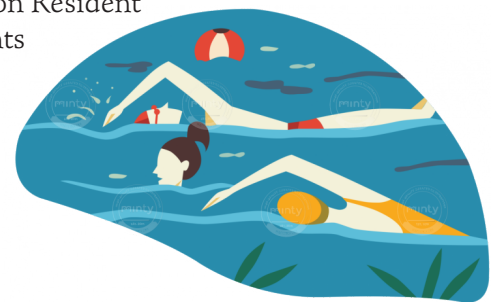
